## **Rescindment of Pathway 24 (Sixmile Park) from Capital Improvement Program Project D-11- Pathway System Connections and Extensions**

### **6.1**

WHEREAS Capital Improvement Program Project D – 11 – Pathway System and Connections and Extensions, was approved by City Council on May 23, 2017; and

WHEREAS on May 25, 2020, Community Issues Committee received a presentation with regards to Pathway 24 (Sixmile Park) as identified in Capital Improvement Program Project D – 11 – Pathway System Connections and Extensions; and

WHEREAS Council is responsible for the prioritization of projects that support the strategic priorities of our community; and

WHEREAS not proceeding with the construction of Pathway 24 (Sixmile Park) as part of Project D-11, will be a savings of \$1,750,000 for the City of Lethbridge;

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT City Council rescind the approval of Pathway 24 (Sixmile Park) within Project D-11 in the 2018 – 2027 Capital Improvement Program Budget, as was approved in the May 23, 2017 meeting of Council; and

FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED THAT the construction of Pathway 24 (Sixmile Park) be cancelled, and the 2018 – 2027 Capital Improvement Program Budget be amended to reflect this cancellation; **and**

**FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED THAT the City Manager engage and consult with local groups that utilize the coulees to discuss a strategy, framework and partnership**

around which local organizations and the City can create a unique experience in our river valley, and

**FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED THAT strategies include, but not be limited to, ways to identify, sign, map and maintain natural trails, while recognizing safety and preservation of our natural environment, and**

**FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED THAT City Council receive a joint presentation from community groups and the City Manager on the consultation outcomes and proposed strategies for natural use of our river valley no later than October 31, 2020.**
